D. GENERAL CONDITONS



- 1 Applications shall be invited from the aspirant candidates through an advertisement at least in two leading newspapers (one in English and one in Punjabi Language) for admissions.
- 2 Rank shall be prepared on the merit basis as per the criteria mentioned above.
- 3 The seat matrix shall be uploaded on the college website as per the existing Punjab Government reservation policy as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13 / 2/ 05 -1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013 available on PTU website.
- 4 Each college shall conduct online or manual counseling. The merit list and seat allotment shall be uploaded on the college website.
- 5 After declaration of result, seven days time shall be given to deposit the fee.
- 6 There shall be no profiteering or charging or any capitation fee, directly or indirectly by the college. Miscellaneous charges like Admission Fee, Security, Student Fund shall be charged as per University / Punjab Govt.

- 7 If any candidate is getting seat in general category as to his / her higher rank in merit, but the candidate belongs to category and he /she has filled his category as reserve, he / she shall be given seat in general category and he will be eligible for all benefits of reserve category like Post-matric Scholarship Scheme, fee waiver scheme etc.

Any such inconsistency may be brought to the notice of the Government of Punjab, clearly highlighting the inconsistency, for immediate rectification.
